#### DEAR NEIGHBOUR

We are happy to confirm that demolition is now complete and 777 has left the site.

Also, Harrington PLC have now taken over as Principal Contractor on site and they are in process of laying pile mat on block 2 and 3, which will be completed at the end of month (November).

Amelio are well underway with the on-site culvert works and should be finished for Christmas, as planned.

As a temporary measure, whilst the culvert works are carried out, the main entrance on Plough Lane has been moved to the top of Summerstown. The Plough Lane entrance will be back up and running in January 2019.

UKPN have installed new equipment in the new Substation, which is now up and running. The old Substation has now been decommissioned and will be demolished.

The Club is progressing with the detailed design and is looking to commence preparatory work on site during January 2019. The piling works started on 28 November 2018 and is expected to run until early march. The main construction works will start once piling is finished. The Club is looking to play its first league match in August of the 2020/2021 season.
