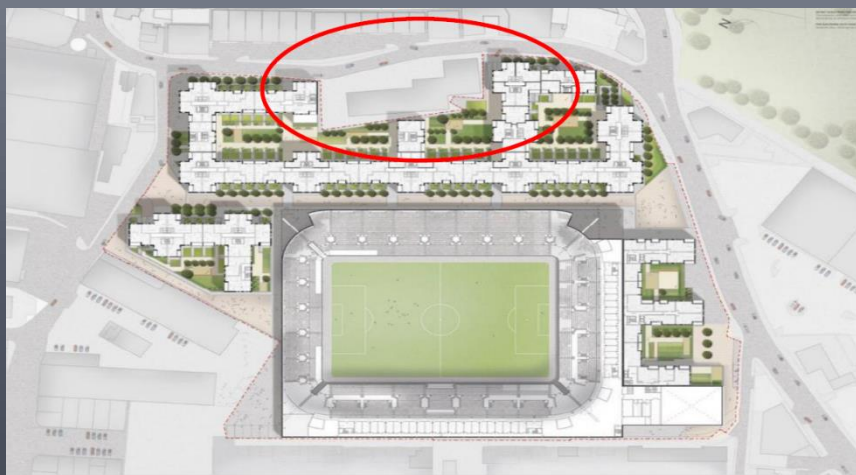

Dear Neighbours,

We are writing with a further update on what is happening on the Former Greyhound site. You may have noticed we have had a new sales suite delivered which can be found adjacent to the existing sales suite which is currently open. This is in the process of being fitted out and will be open in 4-weeks.

Our sales manager Tracey-Jane Lawrence has been based on-site since February in the smaller sales suite and has been selling the first flats which have been released for sale. The flats which are available to purchase now will be located at the front of the site off Plough Lane. The sales suite is open 10am-5pm Monday to Saturday and 10am-4pm on Sunday, drop in to say hello to the sales team. Tracey will be happy to show you images of the new properties and talk you through the model of the site.

The site adjacent to the Stadium (the Volante building located off Summerstown) has now been sold to Wandle and the LLP have started liaising with them to understand their construction plans. The Volante site also has a planning consent for new residential development, Wandle are currently reviewing the scheme design.
